The ISTO Board of Directors, the Coordination Committee of ISTO Europe and the Trade Union Task Force, who met in Bruges (Belgium) on 22 and 23 March and were confronted with the dramatic terrorist attacks that hit the country in Brussels on the same day, would like to express their full compassion to the many innocent victims and their families and like to support the Belgian and international community who were again struck by obscurantism and fundamentalism.
